An open access journal, the WAAERJ welcomes articles in reflection and response to the *Engaging with Communities* conference. WAAERJ, in emulating the community focus of this conference, seeks diverse, broad scholarly perspectives on arts pedagogy. For those inspired by this conference please take this opportunity to explore inquiries on topics of arts education, cross-disciplinary connections, indigenous and minority sovereignty in arts curricula, and the role of the arts in the wider community.

General Outlines:

- We acknowledge the various locales and settings that arts education may arise in, therefore articles may present findings from a wide range of contexts
- We welcome articles that might serve to archive the atmosphere of the conference therefore immediate responses to presented research, workshops, or conversations are sought
- Successful submissions:
 1. Will not have been previously published or set before another journal for consideration
 2. Will be between 2000 and 3000 words in length (excluding references)
 3. Will be presented as an OpenOffice, Microsoft Word, RTF, or WordPerfect document file
 4. Will, where available, include URLs for references
 5. Will style the text as single-spaced, 12pt font; with italics for emphasis; and all illustrations, figures, and tables placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end
 6. Will adhere to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the [Author Guidelines](#), which is found in the About the Journal section online
 7. Will follow the instructions in [Ensuring a Blind Review](#) if submitting to a peer-reviewed section of the journal
